Colossians 1:17-19

DAY ONE - The Words of Jesus

"Let the Word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God." Colossians 3:16

MEDITATE on the words of Jesus: Matt. 5:3 - 7:27, 10:5-42, 23:1-39, Mk. 4:3-32, Lk. 11:2-12, 17-26, 28-52, 15:3-32, Jn. 14, 15, 16, 17
PRAY that His words will richly dwell in our church.

DAY TWO - The Names of Jesus

"And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the Name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him." Colossians 3:17

DAY THREE - The Works of Jesus

"I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing...." John 14:12

CONSIDER these signs and wonders:
Works of healing: Matt. 8:1-17, 9:1-8, 10:8, 18:26, Lk. 4:38-44, 5:12-26, 7:1-23
Works of deliverance: Matt. 9:32-34, 10:1, Mark 1:21-26, 5:1-17, 9:14-29
Works over nature: Matt. 14:22-36, Mark 6:45-56, 8:1-13, 9:2-13, Jn. 6:1-24

PETITION the Holy Spirit to work the works of Jesus in our community: Mark 16:20, Acts 2:43, 4:33, 5:12, 6:8, 8:6-8, 10:38

DAY FOUR - The Cross of Jesus

"But far be it from me to glory except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ...." Galatians 6:14

FOCUS on the cross of Christ: Is. 53, Matt. 27:27-66, Mark 15:33-47, Lk. 23:1-56, Jn. 19, Col. 1:19-20
SEEK the power of the cross and His resurrection in our lives and church: 1 Cor. 1:17-18, 2:1-4
To cancel sin: Rom. 6:1-14, Col. 2:13-15
To cleanse: 1 Jn. 1:7
To empower: Rom. 14:9, Gal. 2:20
To be proclaimed: Acts 2:22-41, 3:11-26

DAY FIVE - In Christ

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation, the old is gone, the new has come." 2 Corinthians 5:17

REALIZE your position in Christ: Eph. 1:3-4, 7-23, 2:6-10, 13-14, 3:12, 20, Rom. 8:10, 11, 12:5, 13:14, Col. 1:13-14, 27, 28, 2:6-7, 9-12, 3:1-4, Phil. 4:7, 19
DESIRE to understand fully the revelation of Jesus Christ: Matt. 16:13-20, Eph. 1:17, Phil. 3:12-21

DAY SIX - Jesus Calls

"Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations...." Matthew 28:19

LISTEN to Jesus as He calls us: Matt. 4:18-22, 9:9-13, Mark 3:13-15, Lk. 6:12-13, 46-49, 18:22
HEED His charge to go into all the world: Matt. 28:19, Lk. 24:45-49, Jn. 20:21
EXPECT and pray for a spirit of obedience to fill our church: Matt. 9:35-39
To win the lost: Lk. 19:10
To help the needy: Gal. 6:9-10

DAY SEVEN - Worship Jesus

"Then they worshipped Jesus and returned to Jerusalem with great joy and they stayed continually at the temple, praising God." Luke 24:52-53

WORSHIP Jesus for He is worthy of our adoration: Rev. 1:4-8, 4:11, 5:12-13, 7:9-17, 11:15-19, 15:3-4, 19, 21, 22
AMEN to the glory and honor of Jesus in our church: Rom. 11:33-36, Phil. 2:9-11

"Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen." 1 Timothy 1:17
